Objective: To evaluate USDF'S current state regarding diversity, equity, and inclusion, and make suggestions that could be implemented to improve its position.


COMPETITORS' CLOSET

 - no helmets (unless brand new in the box)
 - no tack

Check out

- o daily/monthly/seasonally
- o free or rental fee
 - who is recipient of money earned
- o bookkeeping of rentals/fees
- a credit card on hold for damages/non-returns

Returns

- o must be returned cleaned/pressed
- o penalty for late returns

Incentive to donate

- o show bucks
- o credit towards show costs
- special recognition at GMO/Chapter year end awards banquets
- o offer a drawing for a gift basket
- free advertisement in GMO newsletter for trainers/coaches/barns
